

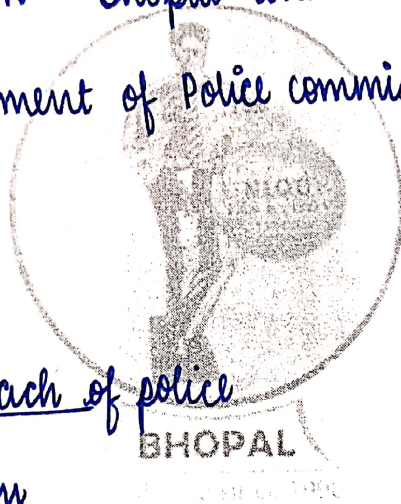
Q. Police Commissioner System in U.P. [125 W]

Ans → Police commissioner system refers to a system in which the commissioner of police is vested with powers of an executive magistrate in a metropolitan area. It was introduced by Britishers in 1861 [Indian Penal Code]

In Madhya Pradesh Police commissioner system was introduced in Bhopal and Indore.

Reason of establishment of Police commissioner system →

- High population
- For better approach of police
- Rapid Urbanisation



With the help of Police commissioner system the Police will be able to perform more effectively. This will help in the maintenance of proper law and order in the metropolitan cities that have high crime rate.

Powers of Police in Police Commissioner system :-

- It can impose section 144 of CRPC.

- Police are empowered to conduct external
proceedings

- The commissioner of police reports to state government.

→ Police Commissioner system in Madhya Pradesh will help in the elimination of crimes effectively. However it may strengthen the narrative of a "Police Raj" as it provides exclusive powers to Police.
